The Newfoundland Club of Florida (NEWFFLA) and Newfoundland Rescue of Florida (NRF), have planned a wonderful Newfie Weekend you will not want to miss! Join us in historic St. Augustine as we celebrate the Newfoundland Breed and raise funds for the Newfoundland Rescue of Florida. All of the details and registration information are enclosed.

This year's activities will include:

- Membership Meeting and Pizza Party.
- Participation in the famous St. Augustine Holiday Parade.
- A special blessing and remembrance ceremony
- A brown bag auction.
- A relaxing dinner followed by a fine arts auction that you don't want to miss.
- Canine Good Citizen testing

Utilizing the power of the 501(c)3 charity designation, we worked very hard with our vendors to obtain discounts to keep costs down. This year's main sources of income will be the Brown Bag Raffle, and the Fine Arts Auction.

We recommend that you make your hotel reservations as soon as possible. Very few hotels in the area accept dogs, so if you miss getting into the host hotel, you may have difficulty finding a room.

We look forward to seeing you and your Newfs at the Celebration!

GENERAL DETAILS

<u>Host Hotel and Newfie Headquarters:</u> We are excited to once again call **Southern Oaks Inn** home base for the weekend. The hotel is located at **2800 N Ponce De Leon Blvd, St. Augustine, FL 32084,** at the intersection of State Road 16 and US Highway 1 (also known as Ponce de Leon Boulevard.) Based on last year's booking, we blocked 34 rooms for Friday and Saturday night and 10 rooms for those coming in Thursday night. Southern Oaks cannot guarantee first-floor rooms. However, they understand our needs and will do their best to accommodate us. **Call (904) 342-2354 and ask for the Newfoundland Club/Rescue Block Rate.** The room rates are as follows:

Room Rates:

\$179.00/Friday and Saturday for King and Queen \$92.65/Thursday Night for King and Queen Dog Charge: \$12.50/per dog/per night Hotel Fee:\$12.50/per room/per night

Our block of rooms and group rate is good through November 1, 2025 after which the rates <u>may</u> increase. All rooms have a microwave, coffeemaker, refrigerator, and wireless internet. A hot breakfast is also included in the rate. The hotel grounds has an enclosed dog park, lighted area to walk dogs and plenty of parking.

Please help us leave the rooms and outside area clean. We recommend that you crate your dog(s) when they are in your hotel room unattended. Also, double-check your door locks when you leave. In the past we have had some very interesting examples of escapism!

Registration and Deadline: To help us get the most accurate ordering information, we are asking everyone to use one of the two online registration options: Register and Pay Online or Register and Mail Check. These forms can also be used to order t-shirts. If, for any reason, you choose not to use the online options, print the registration forms at the back of this packet and mail them directly to Newfoundland Rescue of Florida, 5899 White Sands Road, Keystone Heights, FL 32656. Registration must be received by November 1, 2025. The parade packet is also available on our website.

<u>Registration Fee:</u> There is a \$15.00 registration fee <u>per person</u> (with a maximum of \$60 for a family.) All attendees of the weekend must register. The registration fee helps cover the costs of cups, napkins, plates, water, and soda.

<u>Hospitality Suite</u>: The Hospitality Suite will be the center of all the action: t-shirt pick-up, brown bag raffle, and a place to gather with all your Newfie friends. The room number will be available when you check-in. The room hours will be:

Brown Bag Raffle: Brown Bag will be held in the hospitality room. **Donated items can include (but not limited to)**: dog toys, dog treats (Non-perishable), bibs/drool towels, small gift baskets, household items (soap, candles, etc.), leashes, collars, grooming accessories, Newfie merchandise, gift cards (restaurants, pet stores, etc.), books and t-

Brown Bag raffle items must be in the hospitality room by Friday at 10:00 pm. If you arrive after 10:00 pm Friday and still want to donate, please find Sandy after the parade and she will take your item(s).

Winning tickets are drawn after the hospitality room closes Saturday night. Items will be available for pick-up Sunday morning.

<u>T-shirts</u>: This year's shirt, featured on the packet cover, will be printed on the front of the t-shirt. Due to past size issues we have elected to only offer Adult Crew and Youth Crew short sleeve. Shirt sizing charts are on the order forms.

<u>Canine Good Citizenship Testing</u> – Our club president, Jennifer Arent, is an evaluator for CGC and CGCA. CGC is open to all AKC registered dogs. There is no age minimums or limits. All props needed will be provided. The test items can be found here for <u>CGC</u> and <u>CGCA</u>. Please register in advance using the registration form. The cost is \$10.00.

<u>Lunch and Blessing of the Newfs</u>: A picnic lunch will be held on the lawn at Southern Oaks Inn providing our dogs a much needed break after the parade. Lunch will be provided by Firehouse Subs and <u>must be reserved in advance</u>. (see order form for details)

Special Dietary Needs: Firehouse will accommodate any dietary needs. Please submit your needs on the registration form.

Immediately following lunch, we will have the Annual Blessing of the Newfs and Remembrance Ceremony. We are once again honored to have Dr. B.J. Hutto, Pastor of Hendricks Avenue Baptist Church in Jacksonville presiding over our Blessing of the Newfs. If you would like to have your Newf remembered by name, please complete that section of the registration form. Please bring a chair or blanket if you would like something to sit on, as none are provided.

<u>Dinner and Fine Arts Auction:</u> One of the biggest draws to Southern Oaks Inn is the ability to host our Dinner and Fine Arts Auction on the property. Cocktail Hour with appetizers, beer and wine will kick off the evening followed by a Build Your Own Cheeseburger and Chicken Sandwich Bar provided by Outback. The menu will be:

PARADE DETAILS

<u>Parade Route</u>: The parade route is 1.3 miles through the heart of the historic district. The streets are wide and nicely paved along the entire route. Please start conditioning your Newf now! Your Newfoundlands are like athletes, they need to be conditioned for the big event.

<u>Trailer Seating:</u> We will have 4 trailers pulled by member's vehicles. These are for those unable to walk the parade including people, puppies, young dogs, and senior dogs. It is club policy that any dog one year or younger **MUST** ride on the trailer. Once you are on the trailer you may not get off. This is an agreement that we have with the parade organizers.

Getting to and from the Parade Route: Saturday morning, we will begin loading the trailers at 7:35 am and will leave the parking lot at 7:45 am. Carts can be

loaded on trailers to get them to the parade however, we encourage you to stage your vehicle in the garage Friday night to transport them back. We will have breakfast items for everyone and plenty of water for the dogs/hoomans. We encourage everyone to bring their portable fans to keep their dogs cool.

You do have the option to sleep in and walk the .7 miles from the hotel to the staging area. Realize this will be in addition to the 1.3+ miles your dog will be walking in the parade. You must be at the staging area NLT 8:45 am.

<u>Safety</u>: Our parade safety and first aid committee members will be monitoring the dogs throughout the parade. Water and first aid supplies will be on the trailers. They will also be working with the tow drivers to let the riders know when the vehicle is stopping or starting.

<u>Dress</u>: Please plan to wear your parade T-shirt. Although the parade T-shirt is not required, our group looks better when we are all dressed in similar outfits. Comfortable clothes and shoes are recommended. We encourage you to "dress" your Newfs in their holiday best. When selecting clothes for you or your Newfs remember this is Florida and the weather could be hot, even in December.

<u>Parade Grooming</u>: Please bring all dogs to the parade freshly groomed and bathed so they can put their best paw forward.

RV Parking: RV parking is <u>NOT</u> available on the property.

Newfs Only: Our agreement with the St. Augustine Parade Officials is that our group will be Newfoundlands only. No dogs other than Newfoundlands are to be walked, carried, or otherwise be present within the parade group.

<u>Persons With Disabilities</u>: In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, persons with disabilities needing a special accommodation to participate in any parade or celebration events should contact the Newfoundland Rescue of Florida, Inc. not later than seven days prior to the event. Notice should be sent to <u>Sandy Miller</u>.
